## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT FOR THE POLICE/FIRE MOBILE COMMAND VEHICLE UNDER A REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT WITH EL DORADO COUNTY USING 2009 HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT FUNDS IN AMOUNT UP TO $\$ 70,000.00$.

Resolved, by the City Council of the City of South Lake Tahoe, that:
WHEREAS, The Homeland Security Grant is administered by EI Dorado County on an annual basis and A steering committee authorizes and approves the funding of projects using Homeland Security Grant fund, and the 2009 Homeland Security Grant includes approved project expenditures of up to $\$ 70,000.00$ for equipment for the South Lake Tahoe Police/Fire Mobile Command Vehicle known as the "Alliance EOC Project",

WHEREAS, El Dorado County will reimburse the City of South Lake Tahoe via a reimbursement agreement upon approval by the City Council,

## NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED,

1. The City Council of the City of South Lake Tahoe herby authorizes the Mayor to sign a reimbursement agreement with El Dorado County for the purchase of equipment for the Mobile Command Vehicle in the amount up to $\$ 70,000.00$, and authorizes the Finance Department to load the City Budget in the amount of $\$ 70,000.00$ (in an account number to be determined by Finance).
