Re: Tahoe Truckee Sierra Disposal Rate Increase

Dear Mr. Achiro:

The Environmental Management Department is in receipt of Ray Labadie's email dated April 10, 2012, related to the Tahoe Truckee Sierra Disposal (TTSD) formal rate increase request (Attachment A). The proposed monthly rate for the Fiscal Year 12-13 rate schedule includes a "Residential Extra Can" and "Commercial Can" rate that has not been previously reflected as a TTSD service (Attachment B).

Per "Section 6 - Services Provided by Grantee, A. Grantor to Approve All Services" of the Collection Franchise Agreement Between El Dorado County And Tahoe Truckee Sierra Disposal Co., Inc.:

"The nature of the services Grantee offers and provides to customers residing or doing business in the Franchise Area shall be determined by the Board of Supervisors. The Board of Supervisors may change the level of such services from time to time on reasonable notice to the Grantee, provided that the Board of Supervisors may adjust the Grantee's rates to reflect the change in service levels. The service that Grantee offers and provides to its customers affected by this Franchise Agreement shall be subject to the prior approval of the Board of Supervisors or its designee...."

A review of the Board of Supervisors Resolutions for 2010 and 2011 do not include services and rates for "Residential Extra Can" and "Commercial Can" and therefore were not included as Board approved services and rates within the Franchise Area (Attachments C and D, respectively). However, they have currently been included as part of TTSD's requested rate schedule to be effective July 1, 2012. Given these new service levels and rates, please provide the Environmental Management Department with an all inclusive list of new services and proposed associated rates for the Franchise Area by May 4, 2012.

Once the complete list of new services and associated rates has been received and reviewed by the Environmental Management Department, this item will be presented to the Board of Supervisors for consideration of new services and the associated rate adjustment. It is the intent of the Environmental Management Department to have the new services and associated rates along with the pending rate request, to be heard by the Board of Supervisors on June 12, 2012 at 9:00 A.M.

Per "Section 19- Compensation B. Time for Rate Settings and Rate Setting Procedures" of the *Collection Franchise Agreement Between El Dorado County And Tahoe Truckee Sierra Disposal Co., Inc.*:

"The Grantee shall provide written notice to each ratepayer, in a form approved by the Grantor, of the time, date and place of each hearing set by the Board of Supervisors to set rates. Grantee shall provide said notice at least ten (10) but no more than sixty (60) days prior to each date, and the expense therefore shall be included in the rate base."

Please provide the required information for noticing the ratepayer to the Environmental Management Department for approval within the timeframe as outlined above.

Kerri,

My recollection going back was that these two rates were at one point not included on the postcard notification to customers because there was not enough room for printing on the schedule. In response to your question, yes, we are currently charging these rates.

I believe the Commercial can rate (articulated on a per-can basis) was arrived at by simply dividing the monthly Residential can rate by the average number of weeks in a month of 4.33. It may have migrated a couple cents from that with COLA increases, but I believe that was the original basis of the calculation.

The Residential extra can rate, which is charged on a per-can basis for extra cans left out above the regularly scheduled level of residential service, is at a discount to the per-can equivalency for single can service.
