WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the California Highway Commission has adopted a resolution on January 25, 1961, declaring that certain portion of State Highway Route 11 in the Counties of Sacramento and El Dorado between Railroad Crossing, near White Rock, and 2-1/4 miles east of Clarksville to be a freeway; and

WHEREAS, the State and the County have heretofore executed a Freeway Agreement dated April 23, 1962, and a Supplemental Freeway Agreement dated August 26, 1963, with respect to the portion of said route between the Sacramento County Line and 2.25 miles east of Clarksville; and

WHEREAS, the plan for said freeway has since been revised in certain particulars, with respect to said portion, and a new plan map has been prepared, showing the revised plan of the State as it affects county roads, including provisions for closing county roads, for earrying county roads over or under or to a connection with such freeway for relocation of county roads, and for construction of frontage roads and other local roads:

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED:

1. This Agreement supersedes the Freeway Agreement dated
April 23, 1961, and the Supplemental Freeway Agreement dated August 26,
1963, in their entirety. In lieu thereof, the County agrees and

consents to the closing of county roads, relocation of county roads, construction of frontage roads and other local roads, and other construction affecting county roads, all as shown on the plan map attached hereto marked Second Revised Exhibit "A", between the Sacramento County Line and 2.25 miles east of Clarksville and made a part hereof by this reference.

- 2. The State in the construction of said freeway will, at the State's expense, make such changes affecting county roads in accordance with the said plan map attached hereto or as the same may hereafter be modified by mutual agreement between the parties hereto.
- 3. The State agrees to acquire all necessary right of way as may be required for construction, reconstruction or alteration of County roads and frontage roads, and the County hereby authorizes the State to acquire in its behalf all such necessary right of way.
- 4. The County will accept control and maintenance over each of the relocated or reconstructed county roads, and the frontage roads and other State constructed local roads on notice to the County Road Commissioner from the State that the work thereon has been completed, except as to any portion thereof which is adopted by the State as a part of the freeway proper. The County will also accept title to the portions of such roads lying outside the freeway limits, upon relinquishment by the State.
- 5. The grade separations shown on plan map Second Revised Exhibit "A" will either be underpasses or overpasses as detailed engineering studies may determine will best fit the locality. It is understood between the parties that the right of way may be acquired in sections or units and that, both as to the acquisition of right of way and the construction of the freeway projects, the obligations of State hereunder shall be carried out at such time and for such

unit or units of the project as funds are budgeted and made lawfully available for such expenditures.

6. This agreement may be modified at any time by the mutual consent of the parties hereto, as may become necessary for the best accomplishment through State and County cooperation of the whole freeway project for the benefit of the people of the State and of the County.




