It is my understanding that at Tuesday's BOS Meeting Karl indicated that the Final Ordinance would be brought back to the BOS in 30 days and then was corrected and said next week. It has come to my attention that the item is in fact on the agenda for next week but PERS is very clear that it cannot be adopted less than 20 days after the Resolution. It should be continued until the $8 / 28 / 12$ BOS meeting.

The Instructions from PERS (keep in mind we were delayed one week due to legal review so all dates must be advanced 1 week):
If your agency adopts the Resolution of Intention on July 31, 2012, the earliest date the final Ordinance may be adopted is August 20 , 2012. There must be a 20 day period between the adoption of the Resolution of Intention and the adoption of the final Ordinance pursuant to Govemment Code Section 20471. THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS LAW.
