# U.S. DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE FOREST SERVICE 

PUBLIC ROAD EASEMENT
Act of October 13, 1964, (P.L. 88-657);
36 CFR 251.50, et seq

THIS EASEMENT, dated this $14^{\text {th }}$ day of August, 2012 from the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, acting by and through the Forest Service, Department of Agriculture, hereinafter called Grantor, to EL DORADO COUNTY, hereinafter called Grantee.

## WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Grantee has applied for a grant of an easement under the Act of October 13, 1964 (78 Stat. 1089, 16 U.S.C. 532-538), for a road over certain lands or assignable easements owned by the United States in the County of CA:EL DORADO, CA:PLACER State of CALIFORNIA, and administered by the Forest Service, Department of Agriculture.

NOW THEREFORE, Grantor does hereby grant to Grantee an easement for a public road and highway along and across a strip of land, hereinafter defined as the right-of-way over and across the lands in the County of CA:EL DORADO, CA:PLACER State of CALIFORNIA,, Sec. 28, T. 14 N., R. 15 E., MT. DIABLO MERIDIAN, Sec. 32, T. 14 N., R. 15 E., MT. DIABLO MERIDIAN, Sec. 33, T. 14 N., R. 15 E., MT. DIABLO MERIDIAN, Sec. 34, T. 14 N., R. 15 E., MT. DIABLO MERIDIAN, NE1/4 Sec. 2, T. 13 N., R. 15 E., MT. DIABLO MERIDIAN, Sec. 6, T. 13 N., R. 16 E., MT. DIABLO MERIDIAN, El Dorado County, State of California, as described on exhibits $A$ and $B$ attached hereto. Exhibit $C$ is made a part hereof.

The word "right-of-way" when used herein means said strip of land whether or not there is an existing road or highway located thereon. Except where it is defined more specifically, the word "highway" shall mean roads or highways now existing or hereafter constructed on the right-of-way or any segment of such roads or highways.

The right-of-way is shown and specifically described on the Exhibits $A$ and $B$ attached hereto and made a part hereof.
This grant is made subject to the following terms, provisions, and conditions:

1. Outstanding valid claims, if any, existing on the date of this grant.
2. The easement herein granted is limited to use of the described right-of-way for the purpose of construction, operation, and maintenance of a highway in accordance with approved plans, specifications, and stipulations described in the following conditions numbered 3 and 4 and does not include the grant of any rights for nonhighway purposes or facilities; Provided, That the Forest Service shall not exercise its right to use or authorize the use of any portion of the right-of-way for nonhighway purposes when such use would interfere with the free flow of traffic or impair the full use and safety of the highway; and Provided further, That nothing herein shall preclude the Forest Service from locating National Forest and other Department of Agriculture information signs on the portions of the right-of-way outside of construction limits.
3. Not applicable.
4. Any reconstruction of the highway situated on this right-of-way shall conform with plans, specifications, and written stipulations approved by the Forest Supervisor or authorized representative prior to beginning such reconstruction.
5. Consistent with highway safety standards, the Grantee shall:
a. Protect and preserve soil and vegetative cover and scenic and aesthetic values on the right-of-way outside of construction limits.
b. Provide for the prevention and control of soil erosion within the right-of-way and adjacent lands that might be affected by the construction operation, or maintenance of the highway, and shall vegetate and keep vegetated with suitable
species all earth cut or fill slopes feasible for revegetation or other areas on which ground cover is destroyed. The Grantee shall perform these activities where it is deemed necessary during a joint review between the authorized Forest Officer and Grantee prior to completion of the highway. The Grantee also shall maintain all terracing, water bars, leadoff ditches, or other preventive works that may be necessary to accomplish this objective. This provision also shall apply to waste disposal areas and slopes that are reshaped following slides that occur during or after construction.
6. The Grantee shall:

Establish no borrow, sand, or gravel pits; stone quarry; permanent storage areas; sites for highway-operation and maintenance facilities; camps; supply depots; or disposal areas within the right-of-way, unless shown on approved construction plans, without first obtaining approval of the authorized Forest Officer.
7. The Grantee shall maintain the right-of-way clearing by means of chemicals only after the Forest Supervisor has given specific written approval. Application for such approval must be in writing and must specify the time, method, chemicals, and the exact portion of the right-of-way to be chemically treated
8. The Grantee does by the acceptance of this document covenant and agree for itself, its assigns, and its successors in interest to the property here granted or any part thereof, that the covenant set forth below shall attach to and run with the land:
a. That the Grantee shall operate the described property and its appurtenant areas and its buildings and facilities whether or not on the land therein granted as a public road, in full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and all requirements imposed by or pursuant to the regulations issued thereunder by the Department of Agriculture and in effect on the date of this document to the end that no person in the United States shall, on the grounds of race, sex, color, religion, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any programs or activities provided thereon; and
b. That the United States shall have the right to judicial enforcement of these covenants not only as to the Grantee, its successors and assigns, but also as to lessees and licensees doing business or extending services under contractual or other arrangements on the land therein conveyed.

The Chief, Forest Service, may terminate this easement, or any segment thereof, (1) by consent of the Grantee, (2) by condemnation, or (3) after a five (5) year period of nonuse, by a determination to cancel after notification and opportunity for hearing as prescribed by law.
9. Noxious Weeds (R5-D9). The permit holder shall prepare, in cooperation with the Forest Service, a noxious weed plan for surveying, preventing, reporting, controlling and monitoring noxious weed populations on the authorized areas and within the holder's area of responsibility. These measures may include, where appropriate, equipment inspection for soil, seeds, and vegetative matter, equipment cleaning, and use of weed-free materials (soil, gravel, straw, mulch) and seed mixes. A current list of noxious weeds of concern is available at the Forest Supervisor's Office.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Grantor, by its Forest Supervisor, Eldorado National Forest, Pacific Southwest Region, Forest Service, has executed this easement pursuant to the delegation of authority to the Chief, Forest Service, 7 CFR 2.60, and the delegation of authority by the Chief, Forest Service, dated August 22, 1984 (49 FR 34283), and the delegation by the Regional Forester, Pacific Southwest Region, dated April 19, 2012, on the day and year first above written.

## Exhibit C Stipulations

A saturated soil management strategy would be used to address motor vehicle use during the wet season.

The County will conduct monitoring on the Rubicon Trail to assess the effectiveness of the Saturated Soil Water Quality Protection Plan (SSWQPP); and to meet the County's goals of minimizing Trail erosion, and to reduce and capture contaminants and vehicle-caused sediment.

Monitoring to determine if a closure is necessary would begin on December 1 and continue until June 1. The monitoring period may be extended or shortened depending on conditions that may vary from year to year. Monitoring would include remote (office) monitoring and field (observations and measurements) monitoring. Remote monitoring would be conducted from the office to determine if field visits are warranted. Historic and current climatic (temperature and precipitation) data and hydrologic data (e.g. USGS, SMUD: stage height, discharge) would be used to make the field visit determination. When field visits are necessary, observations and measurements taken in the field would be used to determine if a closure is needed based on the potential for adverse impacts to water quality (e.g. contaminant rinsing, turbidity, sediment delivery) or active mechanical erosion.

The monitoring shall be documented and the results will be analyzed and assessed by the County and the Forest Service within seven (7) calendar days of monitoring. If the monitoring by the County demonstrates that the goals of the SSWQPP are being met, then the County will continue its maintenance and monitoring. If the monitoring demonstrates that saturated soil conditions exist and water is flowing on the trail at an amount capable of rinsing contaminants from vehicle components and capable of transporting sediment generated from mechanical tire action on the road within the Wentworth Springs Campground, Post Pile grade, Ellis Creek Tie Intersection, Walker Hill, Soup Bowl, Winter Camp, or Little Sluice areas; then the County will close the Rubicon Trail to public motorized vehicle use. When field monitoring by the County determines that the above conditions no longer exist then the County will lift the closure.

If the above monitoring is not conducted, the County will close the trail to be consistent with the Travel Management seasonal closure.

An annual monitoring report including the documentation and assessment shall be provided to the California Regional Water Quality Control Board for the Central Valley Region and to the Eldorado National Forest.

The standard, routine, and traditional operations and maintenance activities will be in conformance with an existing road maintenance agreement, such as the Forest Road Agreement between the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Forest Service and El Dorado County, dated October 6, 1992.
