Whereas, the route of the procession will start at Crystal Basin turn out (Riverton Pony Express Marker). The procession will travel through the communities of Pollock Pines, Camino, Placerville, Shingle Springs, Cameron Park and end in El Dorado Hills, and

Whereas, The Welcome Home Slow Ride Committee has resolved to ensure that our treasure is and always shall be appreciated and cherished by the County and thus are committed to making the Welcome Home Slow Ride an annual event, so that our treasure will always know the honor and respect the people of the County have for them.
