NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
Pursuant to Government Code Section 65856, the Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing on October 30, 2012 at 3:00 pm in the Board of Supervisors Meeting Room, 330 Fair Lane, Placerville, California to consider extending Ordinance 4970, with possible modifications. Ordinance 4970 was adopted December 20, 2011, and imposed a moratorium on any outdoor planting, cultivating and harvesting of medical marijuana which exceeded 200 square feet per parcei and/or was not fully enclosed by a solid tence. The moratorium applies to parceis in all zone districts in the unincorporated areas of the County of Elliporado. If adopted, this extension of the moratorium would be for a period not to exceed one year. Adoption of this ordinance extension requires a 4/5 yote of the Board of Supervisors.

The Board of Supervisors proposes to find that adoption of the ordinance is not subject to the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Sections 15060(c)(2) and 15060 (c)(3) of the CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, Chapter 3 of the California Code of Regulations).
