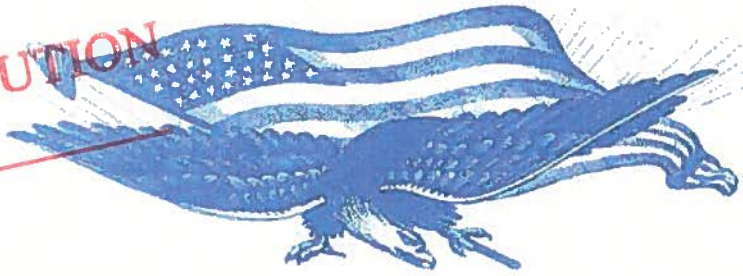

REGARDING: Board Agenda Item # 35 and 36 presenting Resolutions that recommend supporting Friends of El Dorado Trails position on the SPTC

The Taxpayers Association of El Dorado County requests that this issue be removed from the Consent Calendar to provide for clarification issues and public discussion/input.

Two Resolutions, 166-2012 and 166-2012, are listed in the Board Agenda Items 35 and 36, and two unnumbered resolutions are presented in the supporting data.

One resolution says, quote: *Recognizing the existing natural trail within the "Sacramento Placerville Transportation Corridor (SPTC) is a County Trail and a segment of the El Dorado Trail, and further that Southern Pacific Transportation Corridor (SPTC) portion of the El Dorado Trail has been recognized since 1990 when it was called the Southern Pacific Trail.*

This resolution's request is for the Board to recognize what they call "the existing natural trail within the SPTC as a County Trail and segment of the El Dorado Trail. However, there is no historical information given regarding property easements, ownership, and no specified intended use or use restriction of this proposed trail addition.
