

Cindy:

We attempted to contact all of the current AQMD Hearing Board members by direct mail and telephone. We were unable to reach Tom Fashinell, Robert Hollis and Don Nicodemus. Bruce Nixon indicated he is no longer interested in being a hearing Board member. Jean Klotz has not returned our calls.

Nadia Burleson, Dave Sederquist (District 3) and Mark Copple (District 2) did express interest in remaining on the Board. They filled out and returned the attached applications. We are unsure which Supervisorial District Nadia Burleson resides in and have left her a voice to find out. We will let you know when we hear back from her.

Should we solicit interest from other potential members, or is that something the Board of Supervisors do themselves?

The Health and Safety Code states Air Quality Hearing Boards should have 5 members. They can also have one alternate for each member. The hearing board is to consist of one member that practices law, one member that is an engineer, one member from the medical profession and two public members. Dave Sederquist and Nadia Burleson are engineers.

The Board of Supervisors performs the legislative function of the Air District. The Air District staff perform the executive function. The Hearing Board performs the judicial function by hearing cases related to permit disputes, permit condition variance requests and abatement orders. My understanding is there have been very few cases referred to the Hearing Board in years past.
