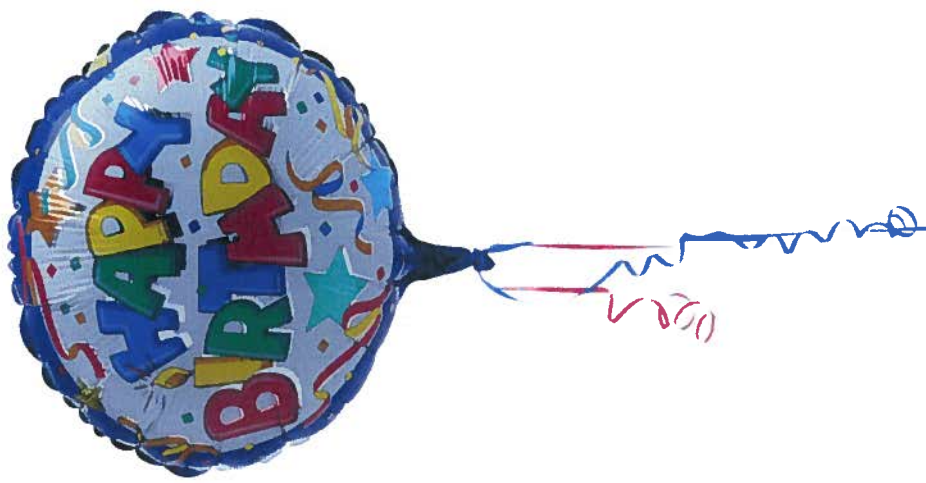


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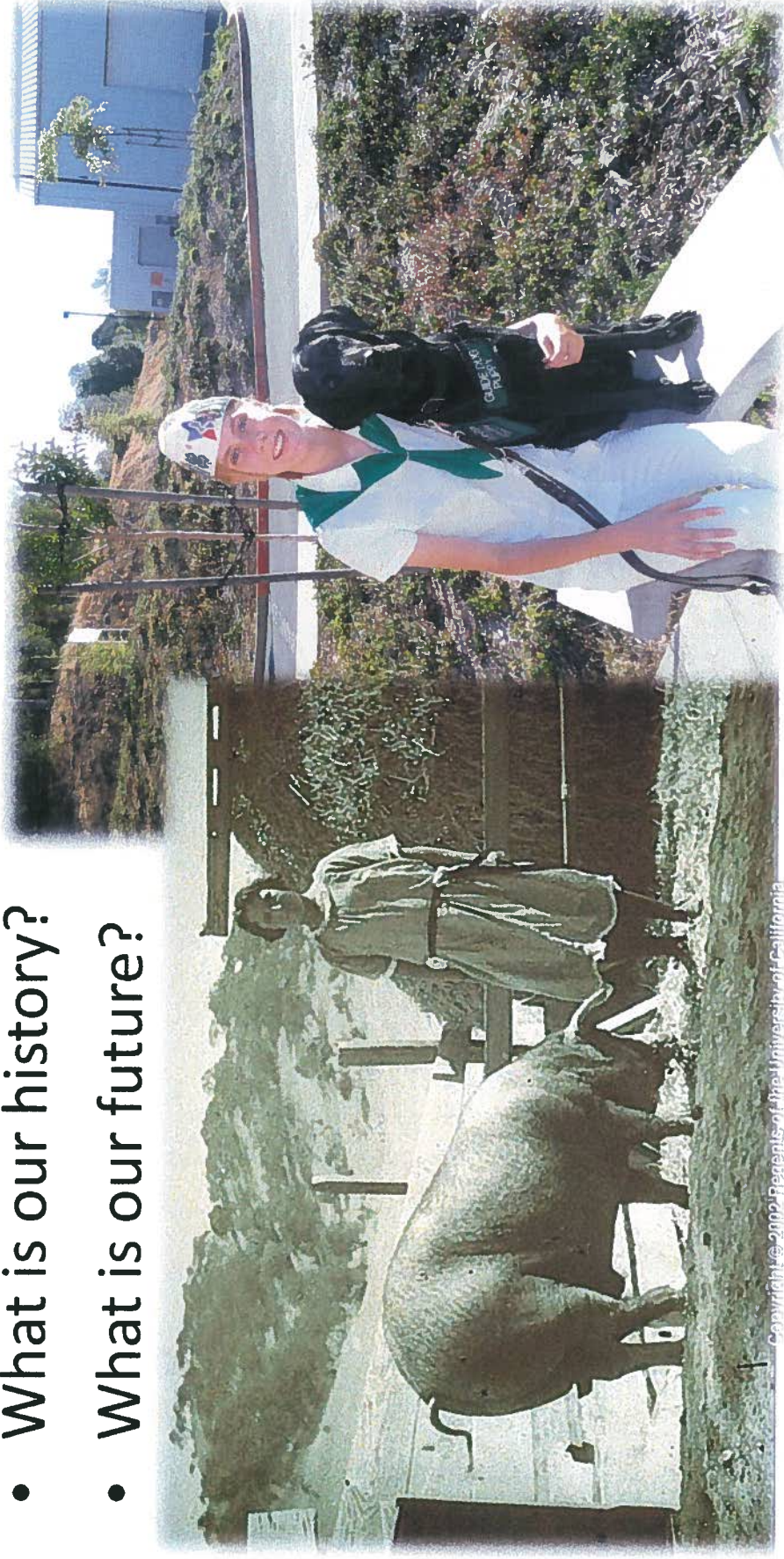

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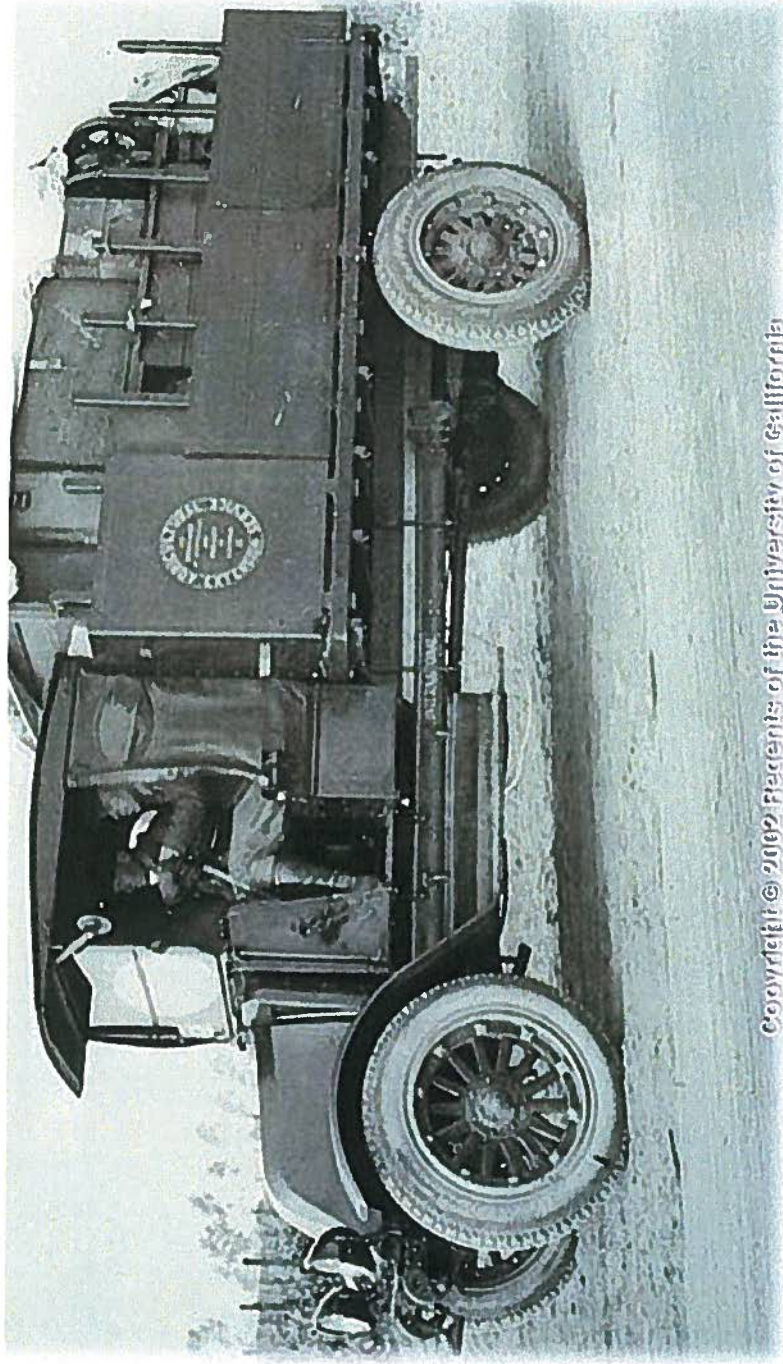
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The Beginning of LGU

4-H evolved to address the needs of changing communities



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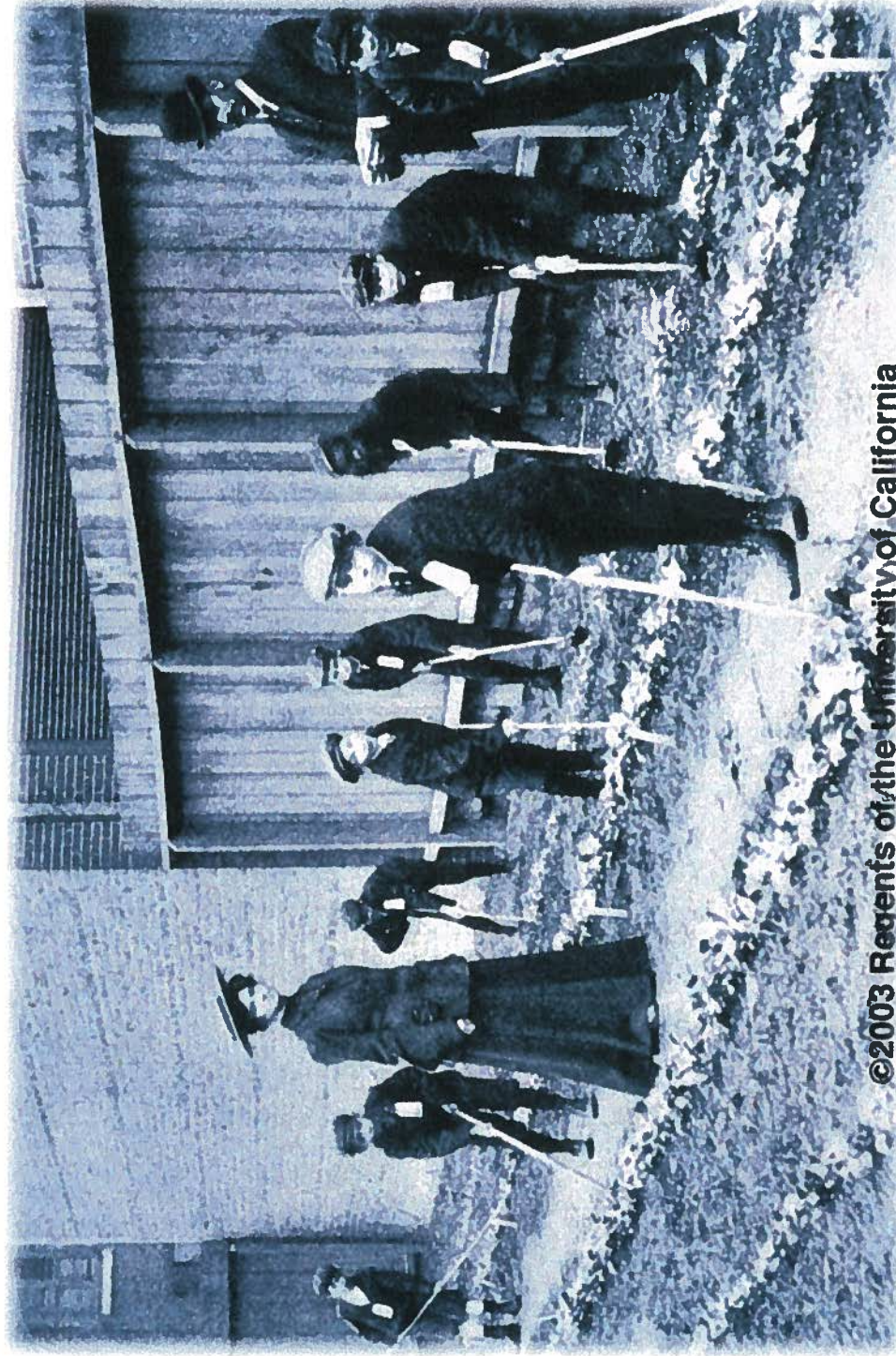
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1913 UC Davis Campus



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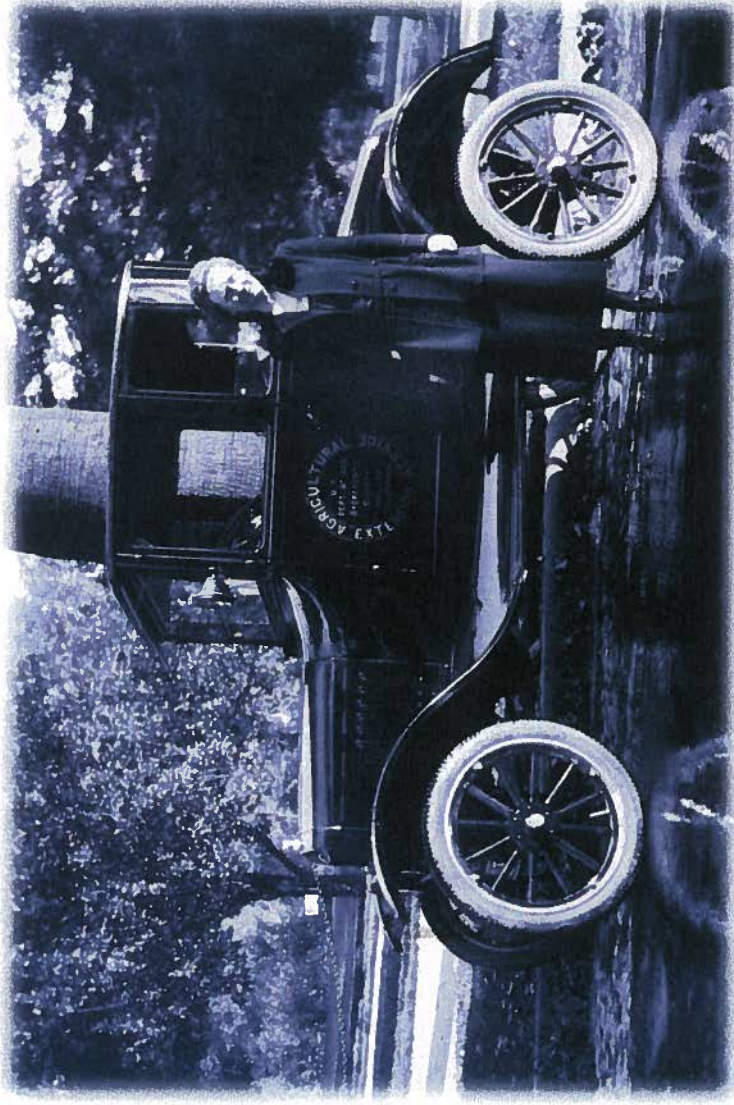
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1914 Smith-Lever Act: Cooperative Extension

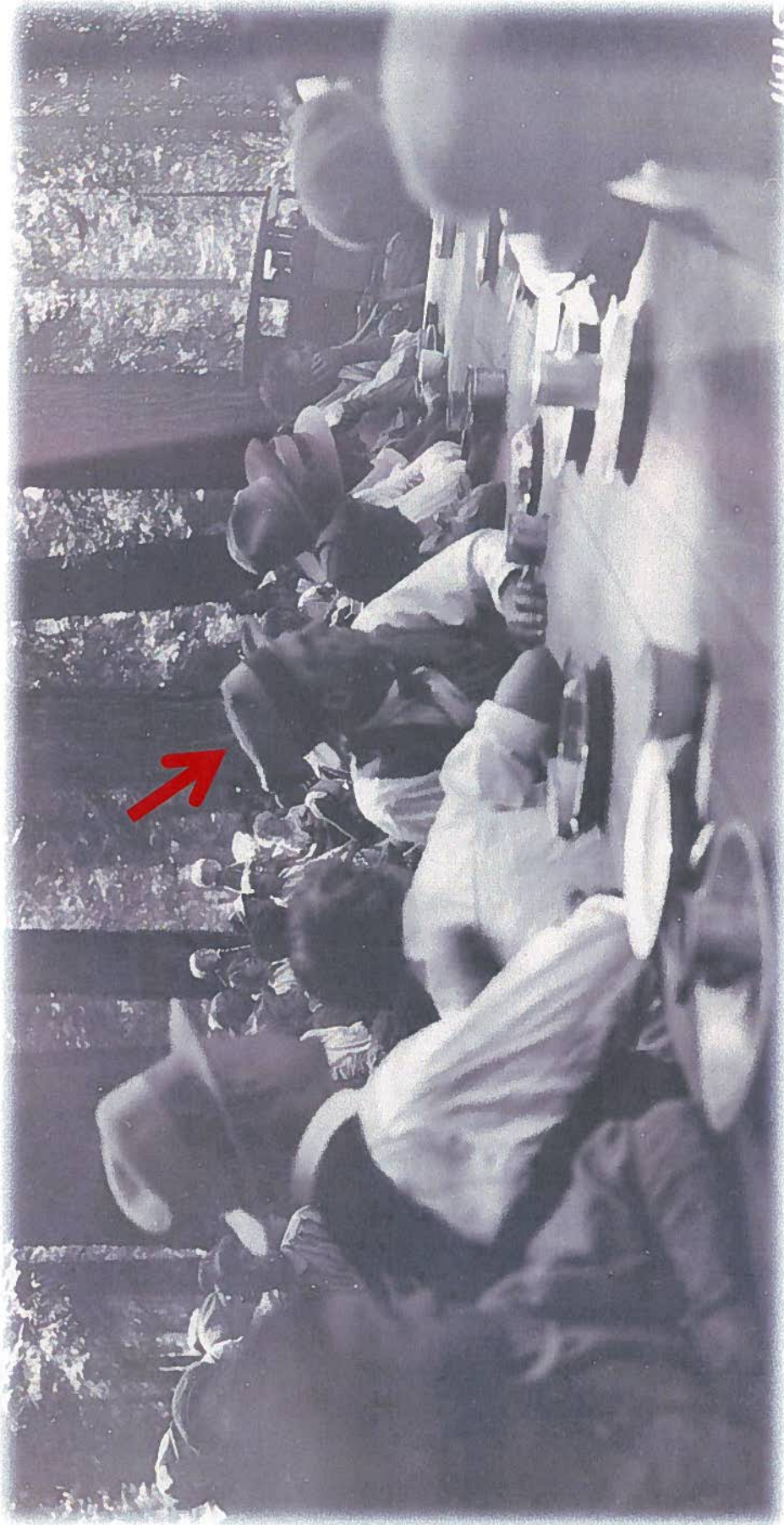

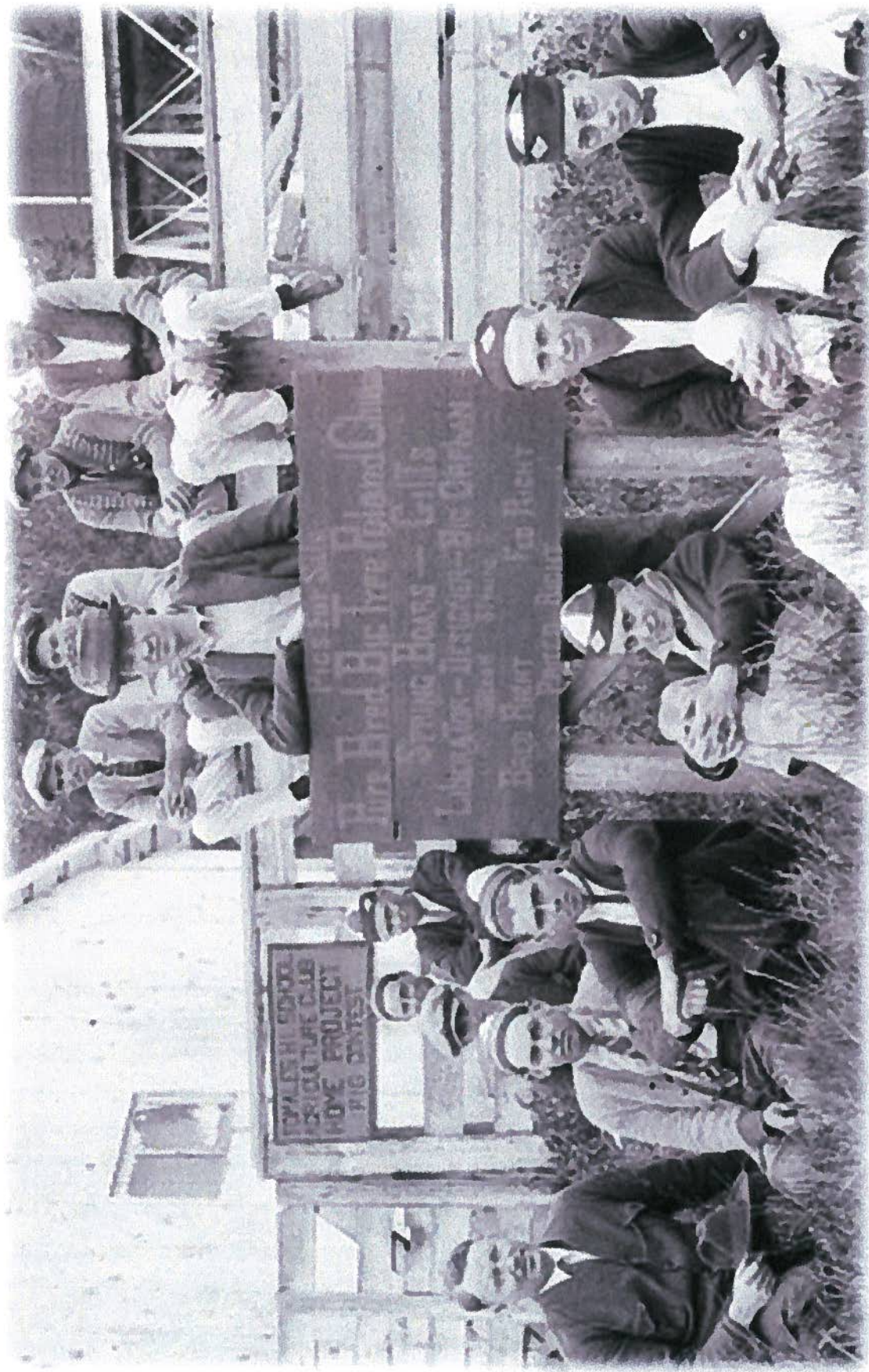


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A great bunch of kids
