GEORGETOWN DIVIDE RESOURCE CONSERVATION DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the political Reform Act, Government Code Sections 8100, et seq, requires every state of local government agency to adopt and promulgate a Conflict of Interest Code; and

WHEREAS, the Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation, 2 Cal. Code of Regulations, Section 18730, which contains the terms of a standard model Conflict of Interest Code, which can be incorporated by reference, and which will be amended to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act after public notice and hearings conducted by the Fair Political Practices Commission pursuant to the Administrative Procedure Act, Government Code Sections 11370. et seq; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Georgetown Divide Resource Conservation District has determined that the attached Appendix A accurately sets forth those positions which should be designated and the categories of financial interest which should be made reportable;

BE IT NOW THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT:

1. The terms of California Code of Regulations, Section 18730 and any amendments to it duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission along with the attached Appendix A in which officials are designated and disclosure categories are set forth, are hereby incorporated by reference and constitute the Conflict of Interest Code of the Georgetown Divide Resource Conservation District.
2. Persons holding designated positions shall file statements of economic interest with the Filing Officer for the County of El Dorado which shall be the County Clerk.


