Exploration Process:

- Communication with affected departments
- Communication with associated departments
- Communication with community stakeholders

Anticipated Outcomes of Integration

- A unified leadership structure that maximizes opportunity for program and operational synergy
- Streamlining and simplifying processes for customers – "one stop shopping"
- Improved customer service through increased interaction and coordination between current department functions

Anticipated Outcomes of Integration

- Succession planning by developing crossfunctional teams
- Cohesive, well-integrated long term planning
- Consolidation of administrative and fiscal functions, including grants, contracts and IT support






