Dear Clerk of the Board:

We went to the County Planning Department to request a Temporary Use Permit for a Fireworks Display on Finnon Lake on July 4<sup>th</sup> 2010. We met with Jason Hade, Senior Planner for the County, and he indicated that rules had changed and that we needed to send a letter to the Clerk of the Board to make a request for this event, and that the Temporary Use Permit was no longer required.

We are requesting approval to hold a Fireworks Display from a floating dock in the middle of Finnon Lake, located on Rock Creek Road in the Mosquito/Swansboro area of Placerville, from the hours of 9:00 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. on Sunday, July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2010. The fireworks are non-aerial, and have a maximum height of 6 feet. The Fireworks Display will be headed by Chief Bob Davis, of the Mosquito Fire Protection District, Station 75. Restroom facilities are located on the site. We will not have any food vendors at the event. We expect to have approximately 50 people in attendance.
