

## RESOLUTION NO. 064-2013

## OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

Resolution to Authorize the Director of Transportation to Temporarily Close a Section of Francisco Drive, south of Cambria Way and just north of El Dorado Hills Blvd. for the Construction of the Overlay – Francisco Drive Project During the 2013 Construction Season

WHEREAS, County plans to construct Capital Improvement Project No. 72186, the Overlay – Francisco Drive Project, during the 2013 construction season; and

WHEREAS, the pavement will be rehabilitated and an overlay will be installed as part of the Project; and

WHEREAS, in order to install the overlay, Francisco Drive, south of Cambria Way and just north of El Dorado Hills Blvd. will need to be closed for seven (7) days, Monday through Thursday only, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, an alternate access route/detour will be available during the temporary closure and traffic will be directed by signage to this route/detour; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 21101 (e), the Board of Supervisors is authorized to temporarily close a portion of any street for the safety and protection of persons who are to use that portion of the street during the temporary closing; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 21101 (e) and California Streets and Highways Code Section 942.6, the Board of Supervisors may designate the Director of Transportation to determine the exact dates and times for the closures;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Director of Transportation is authorized to order the temporary closure of Francisco Drive, south of Cambria Way and just north of El Dorado Hills Blvd., for seven (7) days, excluding Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays, in order to overlay Francisco Drive and detour traffic and to establish an alternate access route/detour for traffic use during the time of temporary closure. The precise dates of the temporary road closure are to be determined by the Director of Transportation, with notification of the pending temporary road closure and detour to be provided to the County Supervisor of District 1, business owners, residents, the general public, the El Dorado County Transit Authority and to safety and law enforcement agencies in the Project area, through direct communications, signage, or flyers.
