Dear Supervisor Veerkamp:

Thank you for the communication and assistance you have provided as we work through solutions to homeless problems in the greater Placerville area. I appreciate your input and assistance with this issue.

At the City Council Meeting on November 12, 2013, the Council denied a request to extend a Temporary Use Permit for Hangtown Haven. As a result, Hangtown Haven has ceased operation as an encampment as of November 15, 2013. As part of our transition from this facility we have been working on a potential Day Shelter to work in conjunction with the currently operating Nomadic Shelter. The Day Shelter will provide a location to be out of the weather, as well as have access to computers and other resources. We continue to work out logistics to make this happen.

As part of our discussions, we have reviewed costs to operate the day shelter. Following is a review of those costs.

Total:	\$4,103/mo.
Employee Supervision (9 hrs./day x \$10/hr.):	\$2,993/mo.
Trash:	\$60/mo.
Storage:	\$150/mo.
Supplies (Bathroom and Kitchen):	\$300/mo.
Utilities (Water, Sewer, Electricity):	\$400/mo
Propane:	\$200/mo.

The City is approving the Day Shelter only through the winter months from November 15, 2013– March 31, 2014. I am requesting that the County assist the City in our efforts by funding the Day Shelter. The City will be working on additional assistance such as transportation to transition from Hangtown Haven to this program. Brian Veerkamp November 19, 2013 Page 2
