Dear El Dorado County Board of Supervisors,

I fully support Measure Y that was a voted measure intended to keep future housing developments from overwhelming our roadways and highways.

I understand that Highway 50 currently has a "Level of Service F" which translates to no more future single-family residential subdivision development projects that can be approved until improvements are made to relieve the congestion on Highway 50.

I moved from Sacramento to El Dorado County three years ago because I wanted to live in a rural community. The proposed expansion of high density housing in Shingle Springs gravely concerns me when the county presently has 15,832 buildable residential lots. Not only will the wonderful rural aspect of the area be ruined, but the infrastructure is not in place to sustain such expansion.

As it is right now, traversing Ponderosa over Highway 50 with the light sequencing as it is currently configured is extremely difficult. What will happen if 1,000 more homes are added to the area since Ponderosa is a major access road???

I understand the need for the county to sustain its economic equilibrium, but it is imperative that it be done so carefully and with the support of the community. El Dorado County is a wonderful county to live in. The residents can be the county's advocates or impediments. Ignoring the community can only have an adverse outcome. I urge all of you to give serious consideration to decisions made that will have a long term and profound impact on the community.
