SUBJECT: Agricultural Commission appointment for January 2014 Board Meeting

The Agricultural Commission is comprised of seven members, not officials of the county, appointed by the Board of Supervisors, representing the following industries: Forestry/Related (1), Livestock (2), Fruit and Nut Farming (2), Agricultural Processing (1), and Other Agricultural Interests (1).

In accordance with Agricultural Commission Bylaws adopted by the Board of Supervisors on August 31, 2004, a Notice of Terms of Office Expiration was submitted to the local newspapers and to county agricultural organizations. In addition, an independent Review Panel comprised of industry representatives as identified in the Agricultural Commission By-Laws § 4(a), was scheduled to meet on December 2, 2013, to review applications and interview candidates. The position of Livestock Industry was up for re-appointment. Applications were required to be submitted by close of business November 22, 2013. As a result of the notifications, the incumbent was the only member to apply thus revoking the necessity for convening the review panel.

It is my recommendation to the Board of Supervisors to re-appoint Tim Neilsen to represent the Livestock Industry on the County of El Dorado Agricultural Commission for a four (4) year term beginning January, 2014.

Following the Board's action to re-appoint Tim Neilsen, with a term of four years (January 2014 to January 2018), Mr. Neilsen's term will begin at the regular scheduled Agricultural Commission meeting of January 8, 2014.
