**Recognizing the Retirement of**  
**Kelly Keenan, Unit Chief**

**WHEREAS**, Unit Chief Kelly Keenan has given more than 30 years of outstanding service.

**WHEREAS**, Kelly served more than six years as a Forestry Aid and Assistant in Monterey County, Mendocino County and on the Jackson State Demonstration Forest.

**WHEREAS**, Upon leaving his position in Mendocino County in 1988, Kelly worked as a Forester I in the Nevada Yuba Placer Unit and promoted to Forester II on July 1, 1998, all within the Nevada Yuba Placer Unit (NEU).

**WHEREAS**, After serving 16 years in NEU, Kelly Keenan transferred to the Amador El Dorado Unit (AEU), in El Dorado County, and was assigned as the Division Chief at Growlersburg Conservation Camp on September 6, 2004.

**WHEREAS**, On April 18, 2011, he was promoted to Unit Chief for the Amador El Dorado Unit.

**WHEREAS**, In the more than 30 years with CAL FIRE, Kelly has served as a Registered Professional Forester and Sworn Peace Officer, was Awarded the Director's Innovation Award, and served on CAL FIRE's Incident Command Teams as a Planning Section Chief, Deputy Incident Commander, and finally Incident Commander until his promotion to Unit Chief in 2011.
