RE: CAO Update

- **Weekend weather problems:** CDA Transportation Division Maintenance & Operations has been very busy throughout the weekend responding to Central Dispatch and California Highway Patrol emergency call outs for flooding, trees blocking the roadway, and rock slides. We recorded over 6" of rain at our Headington Facility. Eleven roads were flooded, (including Silva Valley Parkway, Sly Park Rd, Francisco Dr, Rock Creek Rd, Meder Rd, Latrobe Rd, Cimmeron Rd, South Shingle Rd, Green Valley Rd, Castlebrook Rd); and seven trees fell and blocked roadways. Thanks to our maintenance crews who were on the job.
- **Workplace culture assessment:** Human Resources Director Pamela Knorr has been actively working on the workplace culture interactive assessment, commissioned by the Board of Supervisors on January 21st. A full report on the timeline and process will be on the Board agenda for February 25th when we will outline the proposed processes and timelines in preparation for work to begin March 1st.
- **UCCE Central Sierra,** which serves our four-county area, has added a Nutrition Education Program Manager to the CalFresh nutrition team. The new position has been filled by Wendy West, a ten-year UCCE El Dorado County staffer who has been working for us in the areas of natural resources and agricultural literacy. - **SLT Wellness Center:** Resolving the conflicts resulting from the co-location of the South Lake Tahoe Wellness Center and the senior programs at the SLT Senior Center has become the top priority for our Facilities team and Health and Human Services management.
