



RESOLUTION NO. 018-2014

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

**WHEREAS**, in anticipation of the retirement of the incumbent, a temporary additional allocation for the position of the Chief Assistant Director, Health and Human Services Agency is necessary for succession planning purposes, and will be removed upon retirement of the incumbent; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 1302 of the County of El Dorado Personnel Rules Resolution #048-2013 applicable to represented employees, and Section 501 of the El Dorado County Salary and Benefits Resolution #323-2001 applicable to unrepresented employees, the Board of Supervisors shall by Resolution specify the number and classification of all authorized positions for each department of the County; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution #063-2013 established the authorized Personnel Allocation based on the Fiscal Year 2013-2014 Recommended Budget and has been subsequently amended by action of the Board; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado authorizes the Director of Human Resources to make any technical corrections if needed.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado does hereby amend the Authorized Personnel Allocation Resolution 063-2013 for the Health and Human Services Agency as set forth below:


