This Amendment to Change Order No. 028 decreases funding \$2,811.49 for the work required by ERRG on behalf of the Forest Service for the installation of the passive landfill gas vent system. Due to the significant increase in waste that had to be relocated, the depth of the landfill gas wells (8) had to be increased a combined total of 73 feet from the original combined total of 269 feet. This extra work was not identified in the Final 100% Remedial Design, provided to the County by the Forest Service, and therefore was not included in the original bid schedule.

The installation of the passive landfill gas vent system was originally bid on a lump sum basis in the amount of \$75,000. Due to the multiple tasks and components involved with this bid schedule item, establishing a simple per unit cost basis is problematic and not cost effective. Therefore, the cost basis for this extra work was established by tracking the additional time expended and materials required for the extra work combined with the per foot drilling cost of the subcontractor and was verified in the field by the County's supervising engineering consultant, BAS. The work associated with this Change Order has been completed and the contractor paid in full. The contractor waives any claims for additional time or payment for the matters related to this Change Order.

This Change Order Amendment **decreases** Change Order No. 028 **\$2,811.49** for a revised amount not to exceed \$4,827.43
