



## National Register of Historic Places Evaluation for the Historic Rubicon Trail April 2012

- Criteria A (events):
  - Association with early tourism development
  - The first organized off-road vehicle event and an internationally famous OHV route.

## <u>Criteria B (persons):</u>

- Association with Mark Smith, originator of the Jeepers Jamboree and promoter of the trail.
- Criteria C (method of construction):
  - Example of early rustic road construction technology
- Criteria D (research potential):
  - Research value in the interpretation of changes in the route over time.
- Eligible at local, state and national levels
- Eligible within three periods of significance









## National Register of Historic Places

The National Register of Historic Places is the official list of the Nation's historic places worthy of preservation. Authorized by the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, the National Park Service's National Register of Historic Places is part of a national program to coordinate and support public and private efforts to identify, evaluate, and protect America's historic and archeological resources.
