

RESOLUTION NO. 132-2014

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

AUTHORIZING THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AGENCY, TRANSPORTATION DIVISION TO CLAIM \$50,000 OF THE EL DORADO COUNTY TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION'S (EDCTC) STATE EXCHANGE TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT FUNDS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 13/14.03, the El Dorado County Transportation Commission (EDCTC) allocated \$50,000 of State Exchange Transportation Enhancement (Exchange TE) Funds to the Community Development Agency, Transportation Division; and

WHEREAS, the Community Development Agency, Transportation Division intends to use its EDCTC funding to design and construct the Francisco Drive – Class II Bike Lanes between El Dorado Hills Blvd and Cambria Way, CIP Project No. 72186.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the El Dorado County Community Development Agency, Transportation Division is authorized to file claims, signed by the Community Development Agency Director, for the EDCTC Exchange TE funding for the Francisco Drive – Class II Bike Lanes between El Dorado Hills Blvd and Cambria Way, CIP Project No. 72186
