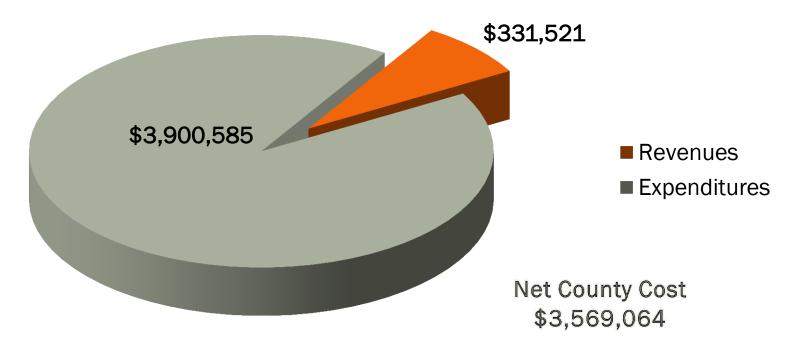

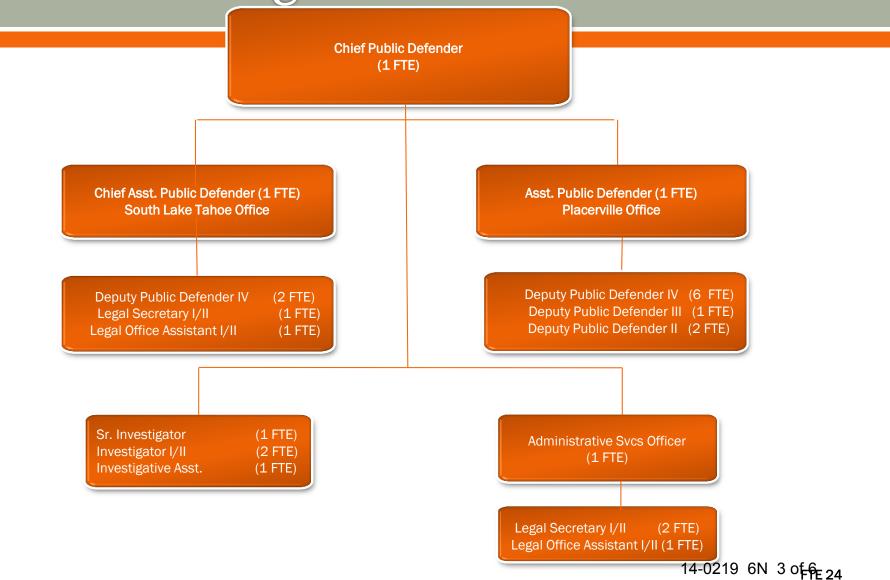
#### **Total Revenue, Appropriations and Net County Cost**
