## Level of Service

Level of Service (LOS) is a qualitative measure of driver satisfaction and is quantitatively expressed by the level of delay and congestion experienced by motorists using an intersection. LOS is designated by the letters A through $F$, with A being the best condition and $F$ being the worst (high delay and congestion). The study locations were analyzed using the LOS standards outined in the County's General Plan Policy TC-Xd.
