

## SINGLE CASE AGREEMENT



This agreement is made, effective as of November 13, 2013 by and between Sutter-Yuba Mental Health Services, operated by the counties of Sutter and Yuba [herein referred to as "Mental Health"] El Dorado County, Health and Human Services Agency, [herein referred to as "Contractor"], whose business address is 768 Pleasant Valley Road, Suite 201, Diamond Springs, CA 95619

This agreement confirms that "Contractor" will provide services commencing November 13, 2013 and ending January 13, 2014 for:

The parties agree as follows:

A. Mental Health shall pay Contractor the following for Mental Health Services:

11/13/2013 - 11/18/2013	5 days
1/10/2014 - 1/13/2014	3 days
Total Days	8 days
Rate per Day	\$325.00
Total Cost	\$2,600.00

Total Not to Exceed: \$2,600.00

- B. Contractor shall furnish Mental Health with a timely itemized invoice(s) for services provided pursuant to this agreement. The invoices(s) shall include the name of the client served, dates of service and type of service provided.
- C. This agreement is not assignable and may be terminated by either party on five days written notice to the other.
- D. It is agreed that this agreement shall be governed by, construed, and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of California.
- E. Contractor certifies that it has not been listed by a Federal Agency as debarred, excluded or otherwise ineligible for participation in federally funded health care programs and shall notify Mental Health immediately in the event such exclusion takes place.
- F. To the extent permitted by law, Contractor retains professional and administrative responsibility for the services rendered.
