

## Recognition by the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado Camino Community Action Committee

- Out of the meetings held by the Sierra Economic Development District, a small group of participants formed the Camino Community Action Committee (Camino CAC).
- The Camino CAC held their first official meeting in October 2002, inviting as many people as possible by word of mouth. From there they asked as many as possible to get involved and to provide their email addresses so information and future meeting dates could be shared.
- The fruits of these efforts in the early years by the Camino CAC now yields an email database of over 200 local, caring residents that want to make a difference in their community.
- From their Sierra Economic Development District roots they have tackled projects related to potential
  major developments being considered for the mill property, including mixed use areas with a walkable
  community feel; providing the community perspective and impacts. This effort unfortunately did not reach
  fruition.
- And then there are the many community fundraising events: Camino National Night Out, Annual Camino Clean Up Day, the Barn Dance and Camino Serves. All to support and foster a sense of community for the residents of Camino.
