Generator Project: Facilities will be starting this week and working through the end of the year with the Generator Replacement Project. The project will take a little longer than some might expect because of an extended order/fabrication time for the large generator. When finished, the County will have a much more stable backup power system.

The project phases include:

1) Site Demo in back between buildings A \& B: September 13th through October 9th.
2) Generator order, fabrication and delivery: September 22nd through December 4th.
3) Building and Site Modifications: September 16th through December 15 th.

Additionally, we will be removing an abandoned underground diesel storage tank from the previous generator. This will affect several parking stalls next to the existing portable generator in front of building B. We will also need to remove a large section of the walkway in order to gain access to the tank. This work will commence within a couple of weeks and take approximately a week to complete. The parking lot and sidewalk will be returned to normal condition.

County's Appeal of the Record of Decision by US Forest Service: All 10 other appellants dropped their appeals of the 42 Road decision following the Board of Supervisors approval last Tuesday of the informal disposition agreement (Item 30 of the September 10, 2013 Board of Supervisors Meeting). The Forest Service can now begin implementation of the Record of Decision without the threat of litigation against the Final Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement.


Road Closure: The Transportation Division of El Dorado County's Community Development Agency will implement full daytime closures of both directions of Francisco Drive between El Dorado Hills Boulevard and Embarcadero Drive/Cambria Way. The closures will take place daily between 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. from Monday, September 23 through Thursday, September 26, and from Monday, September 30 through Wednesday, October 2.

The closures are necessary to reconstruct the Francisco Drive pavement. Motorists will be able to access Cambria Way and Embarcadero Drive from the Green Valley Road end of Francisco Drive at all times.

During the closure, motorists wishing to use Francisco Drive to pass between Green Valley Road and El Dorado Hills Boulevard will be detoured to El Dorado Hills Boulevard. Motorists are encouraged to take other alternate routes around the area which also bypass the closure. Portable changeable message signs will be placed around the work zone to keep motorists updated on any changes to the timing of the closures.
