Subject: Mt. Murphy Intrusions & No Trespassing Signs

Several people have inquired as where to acquire the custom **"No Trespassing"** signs posted at the main entrances to my property. I highly recommend **Lusty's Custom Signs** located at 189 Palm Avenue (off Hwy 49) in Auburn, phone 885-9206.



"Unauthorized Entrance" means not even the Sheriff, DFW or MGDGP staff is authorized to enter this domain without advance notice or my expressed permission.

Please note these signs are posted for several very good reasons. To name a few:

- 1) I've been shot at in my own front yard by 2 guys in a white pickup truck on a Sunday morning.
- 2) 3 electric gates have been forced and irreparably broken by individuals who choose to ignore warning signs to KEEP OUT & NO TURNAROUND.
- 3) Frequent poachers, vandals and arsonists.
- 4) Several thefts of tools and surveillance cameras.
- 5) Intruders in the wee hours of the morning shining flashlights in my windows.
- 6) Intimidation tactics & harassment (i.e. several occasions water spigots have been turned on full blast after midnight and rocks left stacked indicating a not-so-friendly message.)
- 7) Cut fences, twisted wire and removed "No Trespassing/No Hunting" signs.

Signs do not afford protection from intruders, but they do mean what they say. The guy pictured with the gun clearly constituted a threat. Consequences for violation of the law will be justifiably enforced by whatever means necessary to protect the occupants of this land.

The subject of jurisdiction has been the subject of several meetings with Sheriff D'Agostini, MGDSPH staff, Board of Supervisors, and Code Enforcement. The sad reality is law enforcement is typically short staffed and unavailable to respond in a timely manner to calls for assistance. As one

responding deputy told me, "I advise all citizens to keep a gun loaded & handy in the event we're at the opposite end of the Georgetown Divide and can't respond in time."
