I am concerned about the November 13th agenda item considering the Verizon Cell Tower proposal of installation at 1521 Lake Vista Lane (my neighbor). Verizon previously wanted to put a tower on my property and approached me in November 2011 with plans they had made with a previous owner of my property. I declined to have the tower installed on my property due to my concerns about the long term effects of radio frequency exposure to my family and neighbors.

Suddenly I find out from a neighbor that Verizon is trying to put a tower on the adjacent property at 1521 Lake Vista Lane. A review of the proposal did not even list a correct location, and now I find that the location is NEXT DOOR!!!. The original location information seemed to indicate far away from my home. I do not want another tower in our neighborhood!. There is already one tower in our area and it already bothers me that my family may be affected by its RF emissions.

My neighbor Bob Hablitzel is also aware of this issue and I agree with him and have added my concerns to his. I understand that he has been in contact with your offices and has raised issues of importance to this agenda item.
