I am a ten year resident of Skyline Drive. I am opposing the erection of a cell phone tower in my neighborhood. We already have one that has been in operation for seven years (which I also opposed) and I feel that adding another would be detrimental to our health. While studies of the adverse health effects of cell towers on humans are varied, it is worth noting that the governments of many other countries have disallowed cell phone towers in residential areas and schools.
