DEVELOPMENT OPPOSITION

- Proposed large General Plan Amendment related residential projects prompted community opposition
- Voiced concerns varied. Common themes include:
 - Traffic
 - Effect on rural lifestyle
- Objections to proposed projects prompted request to:
 - Stop review of the projects, or
 - Amend projects to proposed significant lower densities, or
 - Amend the General Plan to eliminate, revise and/or reduce Community Region Boundaries (CRBs) in areas affected

 - Board of Supervisors Workshop on June 27, 2013



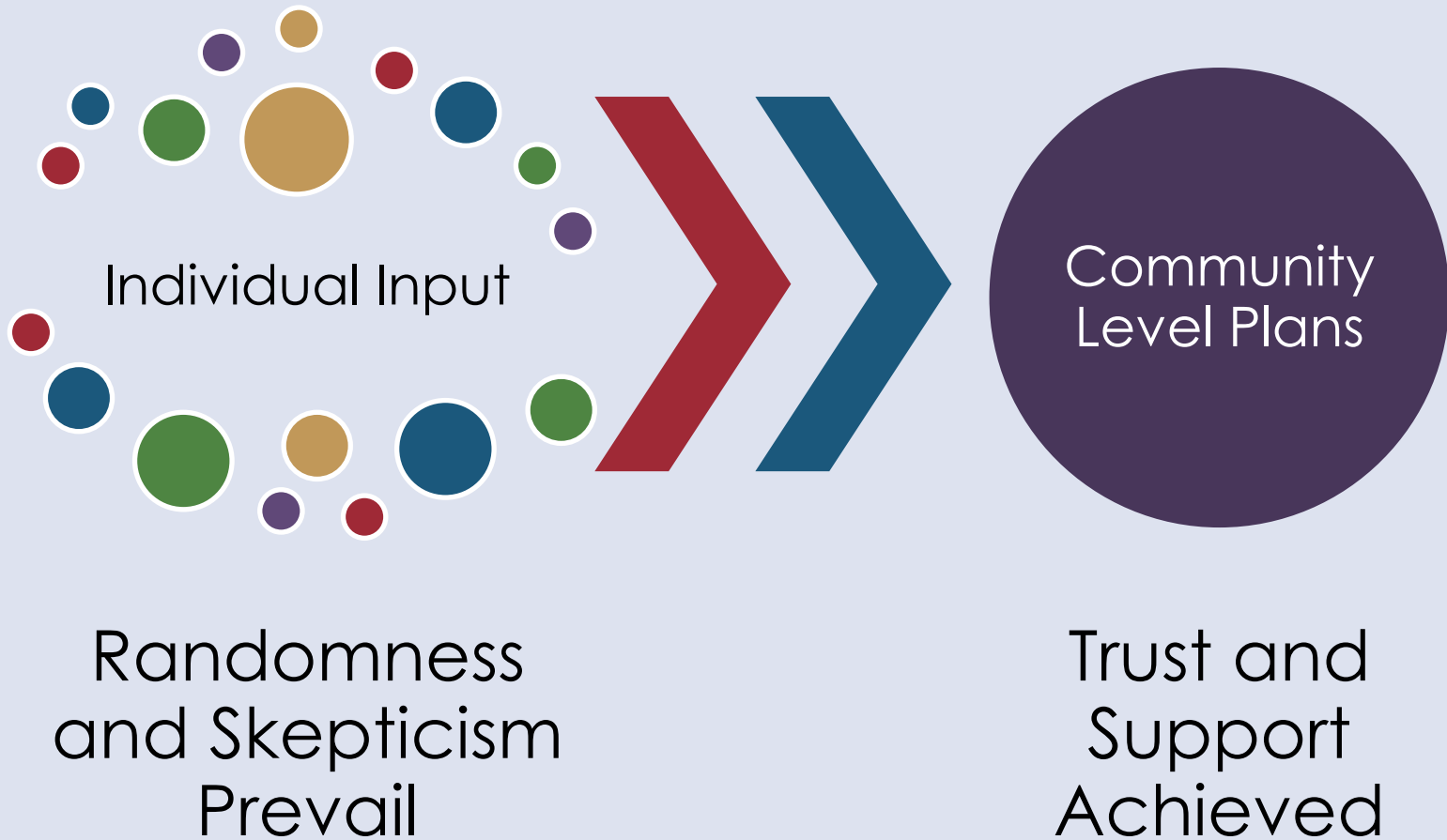
OPTIONS PRESENTED ON JUNE 27TH

- Option 1: Amend Community Regions in Shingle Springs only
- Option 2: Amend Community Regions throughout the General Plan
- Option 3: Re-designate Low Density Residential land use designations in Community Regions.
- Option 4: Stay the Course [Proposed Development Projects]
- Option 5: Review applications that have General Plan Amendments for policy discussion and future actions.
- Option 6: ~~Combine with~~ Consider opportunities within TGPA & Zoning Ordinance update process

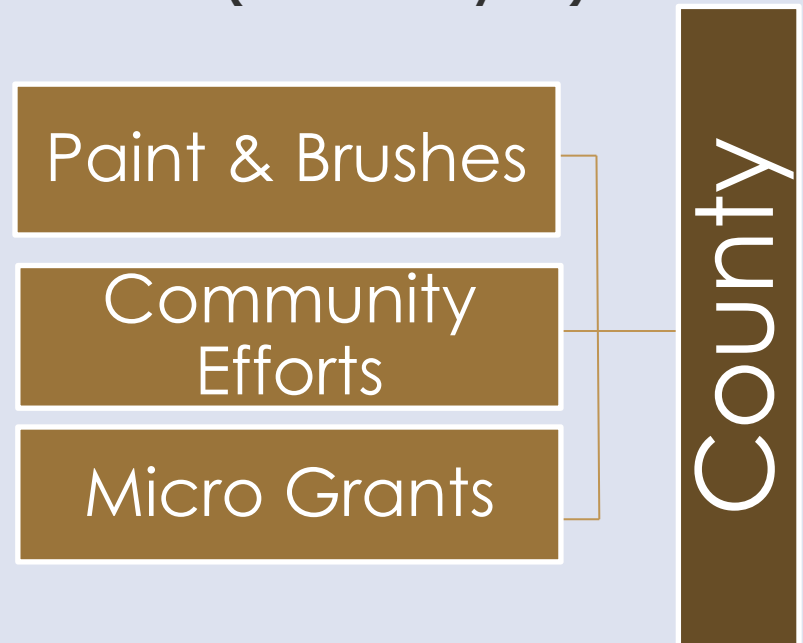
GRANT PROGRAM IN TWO PARTS
