POLICY TRACK

A <u>Draft</u> Policy <u>may</u> include the following for Board designated committees and commissions:

- Periodic review dates for governing documents
- Standards
 - o Purpose, Definition, Scope
 - Appointment process
 - Membership limits/conflicts
 - Term rules and resignation process
 - Attendance requirements
- Mandatory reporting to the Board on an annual basis, at a minimum.
- Mandatory member training as prescribed in a "Committee Member Reference Guide" that would include;
 - Applicable laws (Brown Act and other applicable State Law)
 - Committee's governing document
 - Responsibilities of a Chair, Vice-Chair and Members
 - Agenda related information and Meeting protocols
 - Staff support or lack thereof and expectations standardized
 - Applicable Board Policies
- Board of Supervisor's committee creation methodology

^{*}Member training and the Guide would be directed by the Policy, the process and Guide itself would be the equivalent of "Administrative Procedures."
