I appreciate that you held a public meeting in South Lake Tahoe on February 26<sup>th</sup> and hope to consolidate the productive information provided at that meeting, plus add my own thoughts and input herein.

At the open house, input included:

- Keep Johnson Pass open for local traffic.
- Prefer construction start in the Fall.
- Keep Highway 50 open on all holidays and weekends.
- Consider winter construction if another winter like the current one (2015).
- Make consecutive construction days.
- · Keep two lanes open on weekends.
- Encourage construction crews be housed in Tahoe.
- Look at Mormon Immigrant Trail (aka Iron Mountain Road) as possible detour route.
- Utilize the best possible marketing, as was utilized for the I-5 closure and Echo Summit wall reconstruction for public information and outreach.
- Include Placerville in public meetings, as what happens in Tahoe affects the West Slope, as well.
