Consent items #9-12

I have a quick comment regarding items 9-12, which are to increase the funding of agreements between a developer and a consultant for services regarding environmental review documents for projects like Marble Valley and Lime Rock. It is my recollection that in the past, when these types of items come on the Consent Calendar, the Board of Supervisors has made a clarifying statement to the developers to remind them that their project is not included in the General Plan. Their project requires a General Amendment. Spending hundreds of thousands of dollars is a risk that they are taking and in no way guarantees nor helps gain approval of their project. I hope that this Board continues to convey that message to the developers for these projects.
