I have deep concerns for the safety of the residents, and my two small children should you grant the request of Olivo Vineyards. Rancho Olivo Vineyards has already violated their original permit, holding over 20 events in 2013. Please do not grant them the special use permit to allow these events and wine tasting to continue. These type of events increase traffic, and paired with alcohol assumption, create a very dangerous environment for us.
