

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
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

Once again the Sacramento Board of Supervisors has shown its intent to expand Mather Airport into a cargo hub. As I am sure you are aware, turning Mather into a Cargo Hub will mean that numerous night flights will fly across the County and approach Mather at night. This means that El Dorado Hills, Cameron Park and Shingle Springs residents will undoubtedly be woken up as these planes fly low and slow on their approach to the airport. In addition, as they are flying low and slow over the county, they will be discharging harmful fuels and exhaust onto our agricultural property. Even if we are to assume that there is a financial gain by the expansion of Mather, all of said benefit will flow to Sacramento County. El Dorado County gets nothing except the harm. Of significant importance is the harm that may occur if there is an airplane incident. As I am sure you all recall, approximately 15 years ago, a plane on departure had cargo shift in the payload which resulted in the plane crashing in Rancho Cordova. More recently, a plane on departure had engine trouble and circled over Cameron Park and El Dorado Hills. Imagine the disaster if this plane had come down over the population.

It is now time for the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors to make a public stand against this imposition on our way of life. Tell Sacramento that if they do not change course, El Dorado County will lead the way in a legal challenge of the flawed FEIR. This action must be taken now as there are less than 30 days within which to file this suit. As representatives of this County, your actions on this matter will make a strong statement of your ability to not only lead, but also to protect the citizens that you represent.
