CA PUBLIC RECORDS ACT REQUEST

Pursuant to my rights under the California Public Records Act (Government Code Section 6250 et seq.), I ask to obtain copies of the following:

- Documentation substantiating all Special Use Permits issued by EDSO for amplified events held at the Coloma Resort from 2000 through the present.
- Name of the Coloma Resort campground manager and/or the person/agency on duty 7/4/14 and 7/4/15 when illegal fireworks were reported to EDSO on both occasions.
- Total headcount at the Coloma Resort the weekend of 7/3/15 7/5/15.
- Documentation substantiating the total number of cabins added to the Coloma Resort since 2010 and all inspection permits associated with the dwellings.
- All Environmental Impact Reports associated with the Coloma Resort since 2005.

If you determine that some but not all of the information is exempt from disclosure and that you intend to withhold it, I ask that you provide a signed notification citing the legal authorities on whom you rely.

To avoid unnecessary costs of duplication, electronic copies are acceptable and may be emailed to melody.lane@reagan.com. It is requested that your determination be made within 10 days as stipulated within the California Public Records Act, Government Code 6253(c).

It has come to my attention that Bob Day is no longer a participant in the local Fire Safe Council. For all practical purposes it appears the Fire Safe Council has fizzled out.

In that regard, there are several of us who seriously doubt the validity of the FSC, or for that matter, the intentions of the BOS and other agencies you mentioned to address citizen concerns about fire, code enforcement, and public safety in our unique community. The distinct impression is that delay and censorship tactics have been employed to avoid addressing legitimate community concerns.

Whether that is a ploy of County Counsel or just plain negligence on the part of EDC public servants, it is unacceptable. It shouldn't take another disaster such as the King Fire to address the issues delineated two months ago.

In the words of Sheriff D'Agostini, "You need a new Board [BOS]. All of them. Hold their feet to the fire. Mine too. I work for you." Therefore in the interest of transparency and accountability we ask that Supervisor Ranalli and Sheriff D'Agostini demonstrate authentic leadership by coordinating to make this meeting happen sooner rather than later.

Thank you for your email. No, I do not have an update on the effort to schedule a meeting to discuss the issues of concerns you have identified within the Coloma region.

First, I have not identified a date and time when all are potentially available. Additionally, due to the unique nature of the Coloma region, there are several agencies, beyond those you have listed, that have jurisdiction and/or oversight over the general issues you have identified. For example, as State Hwy 49 travels through the community and the State Park, the local California Highway Patrol would have valuable input regarding matters of traffic safety and circulation. If there is to be a discussion regarding the topic of fire, El Dorado County Fire and possibly even Cal Fire representatives should be included in the conversation. This expanded scope of agencies, while valuable to the dialogue, also adds to the list of schedules to be considered.

It should also be noted that our office received communication from Bob Day stating that he is not available to meet. I did contact him to confirm that he is not available to attend meetings, such as the one you have requested.

It is my understanding that there is an effort to schedule another Coloma-Lotus Fire Safe Council meeting in the near future that is proposed to include a presentation on emergency preparedness. If our office is not able to identify a date for the requested meeting, this anticipated Fire Safe Council meeting will provide a valuable forum for you to contribute to the community's conversation on fire and safety in the Coloma region.

I will contact you when I identify a date.
