



Proclamation

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

Recognizing the Second Anniversary of the Mature Leadership Council and their Outstanding Service to the Older Adults in the Cameron Park Community

WHEREAS, the Mature Leadership Council began in the Fall of 2013 and is celebrating their second anniversary developing programs and activities specifically for the older adult population in the Cameron Park Community; and

WHEREAS, long-time resident Irene Arnold recognized the need for a Community Center for Cameron Park to serve all ages and envisioned a senior center where social gatherings and activities would be available. The Mature Leadership Council was formed fulfilling that vision by providing programs and activities for older adults including a designated room at the Cameron Park Community Center known as the Fifty + Room; and

WHEREAS, in August of 2014, the Fifty+ Room was dedicated to the Seniors and the Mature Leadership Council. This gives the Mature Leadership Council the ability to host many activities and programs. It also provides a social center for folks over age 50 to meet. A core group of the Mature Leadership Council has taken on the task of organizing and scheduling programs as well as staffing the Fifty+ Room each week on Tuesday and Thursday; and

WHEREAS, the Mature Leadership Council continues to expand the programs they offer by including a schedule of history, health and cultural presentations. Over the last two years, they have hosted celebrations for "Older Americans Day" and engaged participants with camaraderie and entertainment. This year the theme, "Get Into the Act" inspired the production of a talent show drawing local performers and a great audience. Funds were raised to support future events; and

WHEREAS, the Mature Leadership Council continues striving to achieve its mission to assess the needs of older adults in the Cameron Park Community and to implement programs to fulfill those needs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED, that the Board of Supervisors for the County of El Dorado, hereby recognize the Mature Leadership Council as they Celebrate their Second Anniversary of Excellent service to the Seniors in the Cameron Park Community.

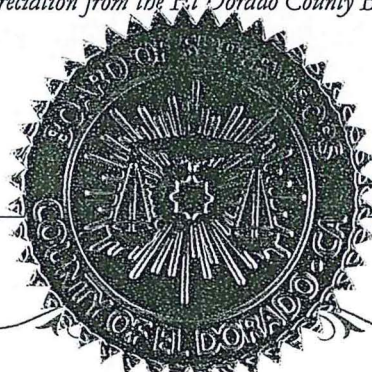
