Service Impacts

- Central Mail & Stores
 - RIF of 1FTE
 - Mail and stores deliveries only to remote sites
 - Departments within the government center would drop off outgoing mail and pick up mail from the mail room located below the Main Library
 - Small stores items will need to be picked up at the same time as mail from the mail room

Facilities

- Deletion of 1 vacant custodian and extra help
 - Reduced daily custodial activities
- Assumes utility savings due to implementation of Board Policy A18 – Energy Conservation

Service Impacts

- CAO Government Affairs
 - Delete 2 vacant CAO Administrative Analysts
 - AB109 coordination has shifted to Probation
 - Fewer resources to coordinate Public Information
 - Fewer resources to monitor and respond to Legislative Information
