Sustainability

Funding for the Sherwood Demonstration Garden has come from proceeds of annual Master Gardener plant sales, donations from the community and inkind contributions from businesses, local and national grants, and adoption by community service clubs, such as the Cameron Park Rotary.

The site is located on land owned by El Dorado County Office of Education and the utilities are being coordinated through Folsom Lake College/El Dorado Center. Water for the Sherwood Demonstration Garden comes from a previously established well on the site.


