# Targeted General Plan Amendment-Zoning Ordinance Update

### **Board of Supervisors Identified Goals**

- Bring differences between the General Plan and other County planning ordinances and manuals into a more useful, beneficial and consistent format
- Create a series of changes (reform) to the current regulatory process
- Achieve adoption of a:
  - Zoning Code Consistent with 2004 General Plan
  - Targeted General Plan amendments
  - Required 2013 Housing Element Update
- Complete A Travel Demand Model Update

### Board of Supervisors Identified Objectives

- On 2/15/11 and 11/14/11 the Board adopted Resolutions of Intention in support of the following objectives for the TGPA-ZOU:
  - Increasing jobs, sales tax revenue, and moderate housing
  - Promoting and Protecting the County's Agriculture and Natural Resources
  - Revise policies and ordinances as necessary to meet newly adopted
     State Laws
- No proposed changes in General Plan Land Use Designations except as follows:
  - Limited clean-up identified through the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance Update (ROI 183-2011)
  - Camino/Pollock Pines Community Region (Previous ROI 110-2009)
  - Agriculture District Boundaries (ROI 013-2011)
- Keeping all proposed amendments and ordinance update narrowly focused on objectives to minimize time and costs

#### TGPA-ZOU Phase I

- Define Project and Prepare the Draft EIR
  - Draft Targeted General Plan Amendments
  - Draft Zoning Ordinance Update
  - Background and Technical Reports
  - Agency and Public Comments
  - Prepare Draft EIR
    - Including data collection and analysis (traffic, air, noise, etc.) and map preparation and GIS

## TGPA-ZOU Phase II

- Project Review and Adoption
  - Distribute Draft EIR for review and comments to public, public agencies, Planning Commission and Board of Supervisors
  - Distribute draft Project for review and comments to public, public agencies, Planning Commission and Board of Supervisors
  - Conduct Study Session and Public Hearings
  - Prepare Responses to Comments and Complete Final EIR
  - Board Adoption of TGPA-ZOU project


## Project History - Summary

- Board direction on the TGPA-ZOU was given a total of 32 times between January 10, 2011 thru December 17, 2013
- LUPPU and Long Range Planning Monthly Updates to the Board 21 times
- Planning Commission 5 times
- Community Presentations 15 times
- Does not include Ag Commission or CEDAC presentations and meetings.

## **CEQA Summary**

- CEQA's objective look before you leap
  - Discloses: impacts, significance, mitigation
  - Involves the public
- CEQA is a process: the EIR neither approves nor denies the TGPA and ZOU
  - Focus is on good faith disclosure of impacts
- CEQA is not a forum to debate the contents of the TGPA and ZOU
  - Final content is a policy decision, informed by the EIR

## Key Participants in the CEQA Process




### **CEQA Process Outline**

Notice of Preparation (NOP) /Scoping



- Initial Study
- Draft EIR
- Final EIR
- Final Decision on the TGPA and ZOU

Note: the Final EIR must analyze the TGPA-ZOU adopted by the Board. Substantive TGPA-ZOU project changes can require recirculation of the EIR before it is certified.





#### **Final Decision**

- Board will certify adequacy of the Final (IR.
- Adopt findings on impacts and a statement of overriding considerations
- Adopt mitigation monitoring plan
- . Act on the TGPA/ZOU

Note the final Bill must pray as the TOTAZOU adopted by the Board Substantive TOTAZOU changes can require recirculation of the Bill define it accentified.

### **EIR Process Outline**

Notice of Preparation Agency/public review (30 days)

Prepare and Distribute Draft EIR; file Notice of Completion

Public Notice and Public review of Draft EIR (45-60 days)

County responds to Comments on Draft EIR in Final EIR

Board certifies Final EIR, makes CEQA findings, and adopts Mitigation Monitoring Program

County Board of Supervisors makes decision on TGPA/ZOU

  - Removed design standards where applicable and relocate to a site planning and design manual
  - Revised as necessary to implement State and Federal Minimum where applicable

## Community Region Boundary Lines

- Options should the Board wish to consider Community Region Boundary amendments
  - Revise the TGPA-ZOU project description and DEIR (if necessary
  - Start a new General Plan Amendment process, separate and apart from the TGPA-ZOU project
  - Analyze as part of, or concurrent with, the review of the privately initiated residential General Plan Amendment projects.

Note: All options require the initial step of the Board to identify precise map modifications to be analyzed

- Board Direction on Community Region Boundary Line Option
  - Within TGPA-ZOU; or
  - Separate Project

Note: Either option require the initial step of the Board to identify precise map modifications to be analyzed.
