### NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

The County of El Dorado Planning Commission will hold a continuous public meeting in the Board of Supervisors Chambers, 330 Fair Lane, Building A, Placerville, CA 95667 beginning on August 4, 2014, at 5:00 p.m., on the Targeted General Plan Amendment-Zoning Ordinance Update (TGPA-ZOU) to receive public comment and prepare recommendations to the Board of Supervisors. The County is proposing targeted amendments to certain General Plan policies (TGPA) and a comprehensive update to the Zoning Ordinance (ZOU) to bring it into conformance with the General Plan as required by Government Code 65860. The purpose of the proposed TGPA-ZOU is to reduce constraints to the development of moderately-priced housing, support jobs creation, capture more sales tax revenues, and protect and promote agriculture and natural resources. The project does not include any site-specific development proposals. This project is limited to the unincorporated portions of the county. The project would take effect county-wide in those areas that are under County jurisdiction including county lands outside the cities of Placerville and South Lake Tahoe that are not under the jurisdiction of federal or state agencies or tribal lands. Communities that would be affected include: Cameron Park, Camino, Diamond Springs, El Dorado, El Dorado Hills, greater Placerville, Pollock Pines, Shingle Springs, and north and south county rural communities.
