NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The County of El Dorado Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing in the Supervisors Meeting Room, 330 Fair Lane, Placerville, CA 95667 on November 10, 2015, at 9:00 a,m., on the Targeted General Plan Amendment-Zoning Ordinance Update (TGPA-ZOU). The County is proposing targeted amendments to certain General Plan policies, and revisions to the adopted General Plan Land Use Diagram (General Plan Figure LU-1) as follows: 1) dividing the Camino/Pollock Pines Community Region into three Rural Centers — Camino, Cedar Grove, and Pollock Pines (FEIR Figure 2-3), 2) expanding the Agricultural District Boundary of Garden Valley-Georgetown, Coloma, Camino-Fruitridge, Gold Hill, Oak Hill, Pleasant Valley, and Fair Play-Somerset (FEIR Figure 2-4), and 3) a limited number of amendments of General Plan Land Use Designations on individual parcels (FEIR Figure 2-5a-i) identified as mapping corrections through the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance Update (collectively referred to as the TGPA).

The County is also proposing a comprehensive update and reorganization of the Zoning Ordinance (ZOU) to modernize this General Plan implementation tool. This effort includes revisions of the text and the County Zoning Map, including but not limited to County initiated zone changes that impact individual parcels which can be viewed on the Parcel

Inquiry look-up tool located on the TGPA-ZOU webpage:

http://www.edcgov.us/Government/LongRangePlanning/LandUse/TGPA-ZOU Main.aspx, addition of historic district overlays over the downtown areas of El Dorado and Diamond Springs, and the addition and deletion of zone districts to ensure conformance with General Plan goals, objectives, policies and the General Plan Land Use Diagram. The Board of Supervisors stated objectives for the TGPA-ZOU are to: 1) reduce constraints to the development of moderately-priced housing, 2) support jobs creation, 3) capture more sales tax revenues, 4) protect and promote agriculture and natural resources, and 5) meet the requirements of Government Code Section 65860.

The TGPA-ZOU does not include any site-specific development proposals. This project is limited to the unincorporated portions of the county. The project would take effect county-wide in those areas that are under County jurisdiction including county lands outside the cities of Placerville and South Lake Tahoe that are not under the jurisdiction of federal or state agencies or tribal lands. Communities that would be affected include: Cameron Park, Camino, Diamond Springs, El Dorado, El Dorado Hills, greater Placerville, Pollock Pines, Shingle Springs, and north and south county rural communities. The Planning Commission has recommended approval of the TGPA-ZOU as outlined in the Technical Memorandum #2, Errata Sheet, and the "Planning Commission Recommendation on TGPA-ZOU Project, September 2, 2015", located on the County's website (see Agenda
