Dear Supervisors,

Please clarify what types of county-initiated projects will be exempted by the proposed Resolution. I have spoken with several people that are concerned that county-initiated projects such as the Animal Shelter and the Materials Recovery Facility will be exempted by this Resolution. Those types of county-initiated projects have a heavy impact on surrounding residents and businesses and should not be exempted from public notification requirements.

Also, at the 9-23-14 Board meeting, I was asked to provide photos of examples of public notification postings from other jurisdictions. Those photos are attached. I suggest using the larger signage that is used by the City of Moraga because it is more likely to be noticed by passersby.

Lastly, please indicate when the public may anticipate the Planning Commission hearing noted in the Conclusion of the September 23, 2014 Staff Report.

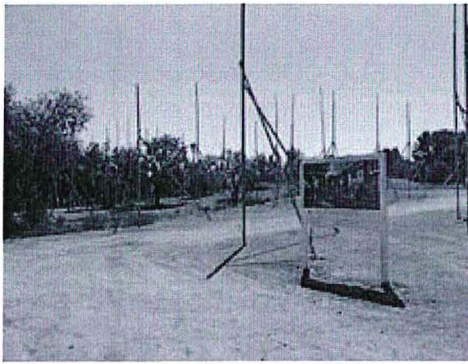

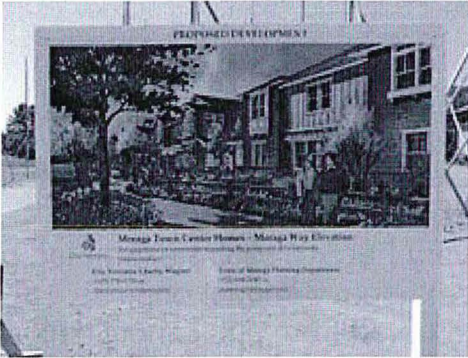

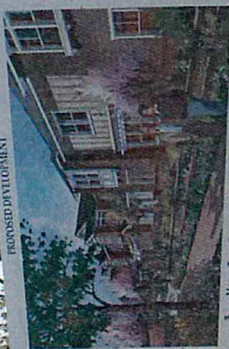
