As a member of EI Dorado County since 1992 I have seen the Board of Supervisors address many issues that affect all of the regions for quite some time. In all of that time I think I have written to my Supervisor maybe once. I'm letting you know this so you can see how important this issue is to me as a county resident.

I understand that for some reason part of the el dorado trail are now being closed to county residents so that some excursion trains can use the tracks. Given that the trail land was purchased with public funds I don't think the trail should be closed for exclusive use by a few individuals or groups. The trail is a public asset and as such should not be limited. I want to be able to access the trails whenever I want to. I regularly drive to Placerville, park by Sweetie Pie's and ride the trail up to Camino. After the ride we always go to some establishment for food, thereby providing revenues to local businesses. This is beneficial for ALL of El Dorado County. Please do not allow the trail to be closed to the public for these special interest groups.
