Dear Supervisors,

Please do not approve and authorize the Chair to sign Resolution of Intention 106-2014 to Amend the Sign Ordinance and authorize staff to proceed with environmental review. It is premature at this time as the public has not had adequate time to review the recent revisions to the proposed ordinance.

It seems appropriate to continue Item 30 for at least 30 days to provide additional time for public review and a Planning Commission hearing to receive input. Such a time extension will be beneficial to the quality of the finished product.

The time between the July 22 hearing and the release of the draft revisions on July 18 DOES NOT allow the public to meaningfully review the numerous proposed changes to the ordinance. This review cannot be accomplished in four days.

The work on the Sign Ordinance has been deliberate and additional time is critically important to give adequate public review of the substantive changes to the document.
