Thank you to our Planning Commissioners for conducting yesterday's Sign Ordinance hearing in a professional, collaborative, and thoughtful manner. It was an extremely long day and only a handful of citizens were able to attend. It is good to see that the Recommendation that they are sending to the Board did address many concerns raised by the public.

Staff did not post their Memorandum of information until less than 24 hours prior to the meeting. This was duly noted by the Chairman and several members of the public, including myself. The late posting contributed to the long day because research and referencing could not be done ahead and had to be done during the meeting.

It is anticipated that the Planning Commission's Recommendation on the Sign Ordinance will be presented to the Board of Supervisors for adoption on July 28, 2015. It would be helpful to all for the staff to post the final draft of the Recommendation several weeks in advance so that we have an opportunity to make meaningful input to the Board of Supervisors.
