UPDATE TO CHAPTER 130.18 (SIGNS) OF ITILE 130 (ZONING ORDINANCE) THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS: The proposed Ordinance is a comprehensive update to the County's existing Sign Ordinance (Chapter 130.16 of Title 130 of the El Dorado County Code of Ordinances, and other sections of Title 130 address-ing sign regulations and standards) as well as amendments to General Plan Land Use Element Ob-jective 2.7.1 and Policy 2.7.1.2 (pertaining to off-site signs) consistent with the goals of the project The proposed ordinance shall replace the existing chapproposed ofcumance small replace the existing unap-ter 130.16 peralining to the regulation of signs in the unincorporated area of the County and shall be leaf-ed and considered as a new and comprehensive or dinance which shall supersede all previously adopted standards and ordinances regarding signs.
