Drive Clean Incentive Program

- Like wood stove incentive program, Drive Clean \$1,000 incentive for White/Green sticker vehicles
- Goals

1) Reduce emissions by incentivizing cleaner vehicles, and

2) Reduce US 50 congestion by moving vehicles from mixed use lanes to HOV lanes during commute

- Cost Effectiveness <u>\$10</u> per pound!
- Recommend allocating \$200k of remaining 14/15 funds to Drive Clean.
- EDCTC/CMAQ awarded \$250k Drive Clean
- AQMD to return with CMAQ grant agreement

Board's Options

- Discuss projects with applicants
- Award all, some or none of the eligible proposals
- Allocate recommended amount, more or less to the Drive Clean program
- Change Drive Clean incentive amount per vehicle

Staff Recommendation

Board direct AQMD staff to:

- Award top 6 ranked proposals (\$496,718)
- Authorize AQMD staff to utilize \$200k of remaining 14/15 funds to implement Drive Clean Incentive Program at \$1k/vehicle
- Authorize the Chair to sign agreements with awarded applicants, pending approval of County Counsel, Risk Management and APCO
